I Can Draw: Jackie Robinson Grid Drawing Activity

The grid drawing method is a fun and easy way to recreate your favorite paintings and photographs. Simply take an image and place a grid over it so you can accurately recreate the image grid-for-grid on another sheet of paper!

Did you know

- On Jackie Robinson Day, April 15, all baseball players are required to wear the number 42 in honor of his memory.
- He was the first African-American player inducted into the Pro Baseball Hall-of-Fame.

Drawing Instructions

1. Print out both the blank grid and the reference grid.
2. Find your favorite set of colored pencils and/or crayons.
3. Use a pencil to draw out each block before coloring it in.
4. Begin by completing the grid box to the right of the already filled in box.
5. Continue to the grid box directly below the box you just completed, then to the box to the left of that one.
6. After completing those three boxes, you should now have all of Jackie's face completed.
7. From here, go box by box until the picture is finished!
8. When you're done, take a picture and post it on Instagram with the hashtag #makehistory
