Dear Student,

Thank you for your interest in being a Summer Camp Ambassador for the Atlanta History Center (AHC). Summer Camp Ambassadors are unpaid volunteers that assist the camp counselors and interns with teaching and supervising groups of up to 20 campers during week-long, full day camps in June. General duties include helping with student and classroom management, instruction, and assisting with the preparation/ cleanup for the day's activities. Summer Camp Ambassadors should also have a great rapport with children.

To be considered for a Summer Camp Ambassador position, you will need to submit an online application, along with the following documents, no later than Monday, April 15, 2024:

- 1. Summer Camp Ambassador Application
- 2. School Recommendation From and letter of recommendation from two (2) academic sources
- 3. Completion of Essay Questions

As a Summer Camp Ambassador, you will have the chance to develop skills like leadership, communication, critical thinking, collaboration, and more. The program is open to rising 11th and 12th grade students (age 15–18). AHC offers week-long summer camps in June. Students must commit to two (2) camps totaling 50 volunteer hours. Your involvement may include providing support for our Education Facilitators/ Camp counselors and interns, creating a fun yet educational environment for campers, and promoting an enthusiastic and positive attitude.

Summer Camp Ambassadors will be required to make a minimum 2-week commitment during the month of June. Summer Camp Ambassadors will also be expected to work 4-hour shifts, performing at least 50 volunteer hours, and attending a mandatory training and orientation session. Please make sure that you will be able to make time for these activities as participation is critical to your success and enjoyment of this program. We emphasize communication and consistency. We recognize High School students have several commitments and club activities but ask that you take your position as a Summer Camp Ambassador seriously.

We are excited about the participation of the Summer Camp Ambassadors for our 2024 Summer Camps! The Summer Camp Ambassador Program is a unique "education through service" program designed to attract a dynamic service-oriented group of young people interested in helping the Atlanta History Center and engaging their community.
