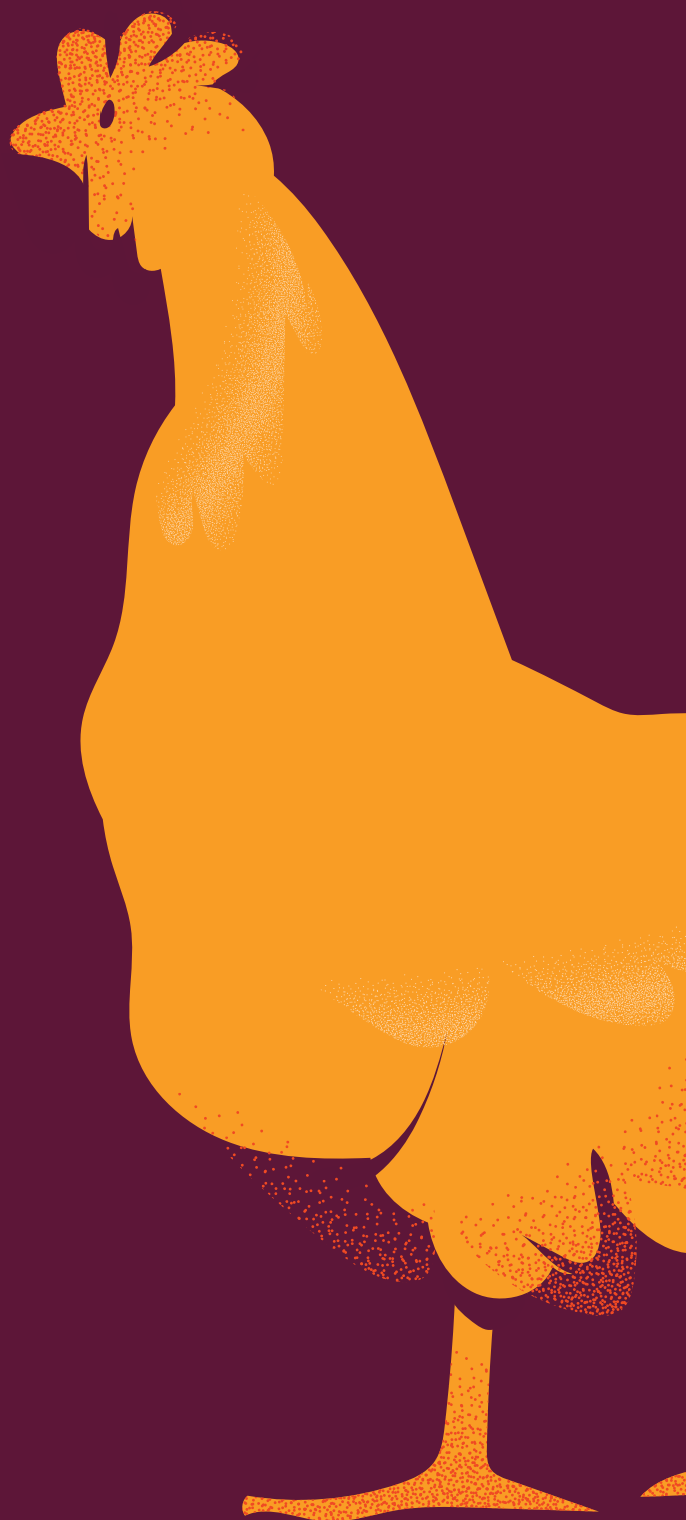

WELCOME TO FALL FESTIVAL AT ATLANTA HISTORY CENTER!

This seasonal celebration is presented in partnership with 4-H and UGA Extension, part of a national network that empowers young people through hands-on learning in agriculture, science, and leadership. For more than a century, 4-H has welcomed youth from all backgrounds, helping them grow into thoughtful leaders and changemakers. 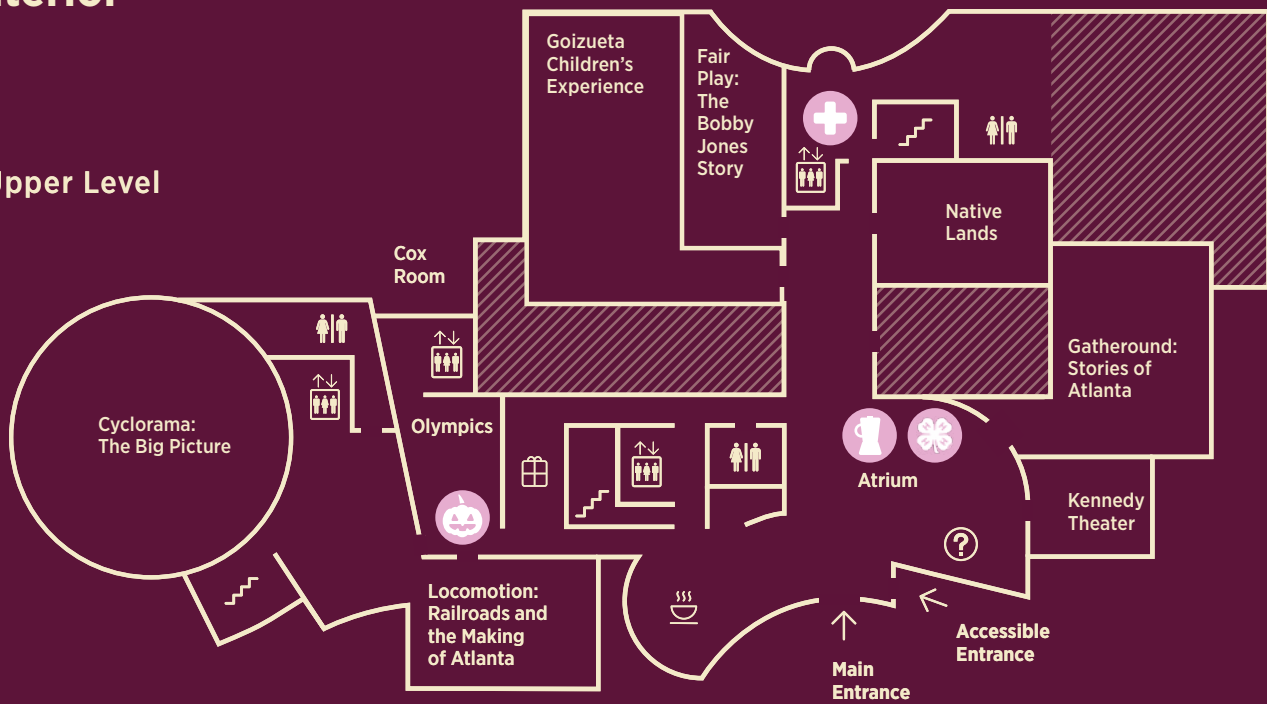

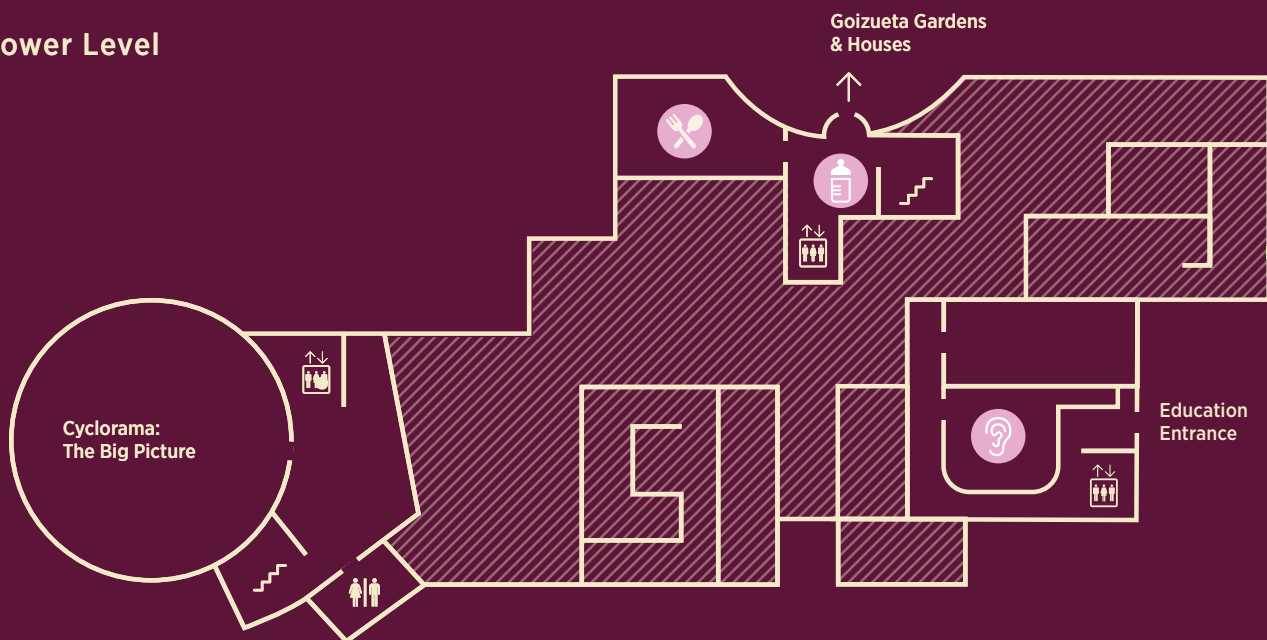
